

Let's dramatize the powerful story of **Doubting Thomas**, a disciple who struggled with doubt but ultimately found faith. This event is recorded in the Gospel of **John 20:24-29**.

**Title: "Thomas' Confession: From Doubt to Belief"**

*Setting: A dimly lit room, a week after Jesus' resurrection.*

**Characters:**

- **Thomas** (Doubting, sincere, and seeking truth)
  - **Other Disciples** (Excited, eager, and hopeful)
  - **Jesus** (Appearing suddenly, yet gently)
