(Anna looks up and sees Simeon approaching.)

Simeon: Oh, how I've longed for this day.

Anna: How I've prayed for this day.

Together: And now it's here.

Anna: For years, I have fasted and prayed, waiting and daily reminding God of His promise.

Simeon: His promise for a new covenant.

Anna: His promise for redemption.

Simeon: “Lord, let your servant depart in peace, for my eyes have seen your salvation.”
